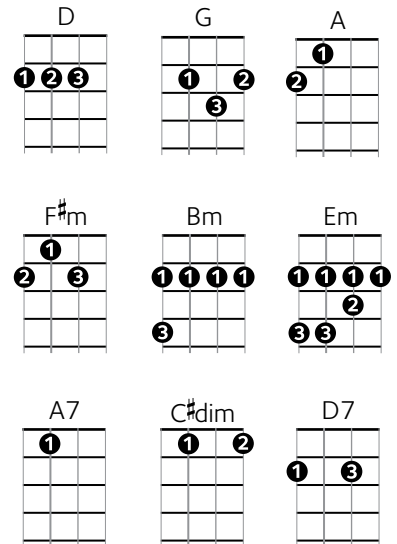
D G D D

Each named chord lasts for one bar in the verse, two bars in the chorus.

You should feel free to turn some of the As and Gs into A7s and G7s, particularly in the chorus, for added flavour. (I find the sequence G-G7-A-A7 works fairly well.)
